

MITO 9 VULVA

Studio osservazionale, multicentrico, retrospettivo e prospettico con lo scopo di raccogliere dati sui tumori rari della vulva.

This is an observational, national and multicentric study aiming to collect retrospective and prospective data concerning patients suffering from rare vulvar cancers and treated within MITO centers between 1990 and 2025

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Inclusion Criteria:

- Diagnosis of rare vulvar cancers
 - Vulvar melanoma
 - Basal cell carcinoma
 - Verrucous carcinoma
 - Bartholin gland cancer
 - Intestinal-type adenocarcinoma
 - Mammary-like adenocarcinoma
 - Soft tissue malignancy
 - Dermatofibrosarcoma protuberans
 - Epithelioid sarcoma
 - Leiomyosarcoma
 - Rhabdomyosarcoma
 - Fibrous histiocytomas
 - Angiomyofibroblastoma
 - Hemangiopericytoma
 - Merkel Cell Carcinoma (MCC)
 - Primary lymphoma of the female genital tract (PLFGT)
 - Paget disease
 - Choriocarcinoma
 - Peripheral primitive neuroectodermal tumor (pPNET) Endodermal sinus tumor
- At least 3 months of follow-up for the prospective cohort
- age ≥ 18 years
