In October 2012 Department of Radiotherpy started clinical activities after opening ceremony in May.

From 18th October 2012 four teams composed by Italian experts for two months gave support to the local staff in Zenica.

The main goal of these teams was to support clinical activities at new Radiotherapy Department at Cantonal Hospital Zenica and to educate the unexperienced local staff.



Since October to the end of February, Radiotherapy Department has treated 52 patients.

At the end of February there were 15 patients on treatment and about 10 new patients prepared for the treatment.

Main reasons for such reduced number of patients were:

- The high number of short palliative treatments,
- no radical treatments of some pathologies(e.g. head&neck)


